The credit granting policy in effect at Brigham Young University for Advanced Placement Examinations taken during May 2005 is listed below. Every full-year AP course will earn a minimum of six semester hours of credit and each half-year AP course will earn a minimum of 3 semester hours of credit for examination scores of 3, 4, or 5.
