CONTINUING STUDENT ENROLLMENT AND SCHOLARSHIP DEFERMENT APPLICATION

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS



To defer enrollment and scholarship (if applicable) for one semester without reapplying, you must:

1. Be a day-time student during an eight (8) month period immediately prior to requesting the deferment.
2. Be readmissible to the university.
3. Submit this form before the application deadline of the semester you are wanting to return.

NOTE: This deferment is for one semester only. You must reenroll at the university in the semester or term immediately following your absence (i.e. if you do not attend winter semester 2001, you must reenroll spring term 2001; or if you do not attend fall semester 2001, you must reenroll winter semester 2002). International students who plan to interrupt their studies for more than one semester should contact the Admissions Office for the appropriate reapplication materials.

If you have registered for classes, it is your responsibility to drop these courses before the first day of the semester or term to which you have enrolled. If you fail to drop your courses, you will be charged tuition according to the discontinuance guidelines listed in the current class schedule bulletin. If you have questions on how to withdraw consult

your class schedule or call the Registration Office, telephone (801) 378-2824.

If you submit your deferment after school has begun you also need to see the discontinuance office, B-150 ASB, telephone (801) 378-7705. You will be charged tuition for every day you are enrolled in classes.

After completing this page, you must interview with your ecclesiastical leader to complete the endorsement on the reverse side.

This form cannot be used in conjunction with the Mission Deferment form. LDS missionaries must complete the Missionary Enrollment and Scholarship Deferment Application.

NOTE: Students who have previously received a Federal Student Loan (FSL) should contact the Financial Aid Office before submitting this form. By deferring admission, you may be required to begin repayment of your loan.
